Why such a Club?

Who may join?

Any person who has paid the membership fees for the financial year. No provision is made for patrons or non-paying honorary members. Membership can be renewed annually and lasts from 1 March or thereafter until the end of February of the following year.

What does it cost?

For individual members: R50 per financial year (or part thereof);

For lifetime membership: R300 as a once off payment.

What will the money be used for?

To contribute to the exposure of the ABW Monument and the optimal utilization of all the facilities, administrative costs and maintenance.

Who manages the club?

The Chairman or any member of the Trust acts ex officio as convener of the Club and accepts responsibility for the effective management and functioning of the Club.

What do members get in exchange?

Membership is an honorary association, without members having any direct say in the management of the ABW Monument. Input and advice from members will nevertheless be appreciated.
